Celebration: The Exaltation of Christ through Worship

"Because of that obedience." Rational

The Church, as the redeemed of Christ, gathers in adoration, exultation and praise, in celebration worship of her Lord. This should be a dynamic experience through which each worshipping believer experiences the presence of God and gives witness to the Lordship of Christ.

Healing: Care and Repair of the Hurting

Rational

Christians and all people from time-to-time experience trials, tragedies, traumas, temptations, and the failure of trespasses. Our Church is to be a community of care and repair for those with hurts. A community where those who are spiritual restore with gentleness those who are weak, where we carry one another's burdens by offering assistance and providing support, so that those with needs may be helped in the name of Christ.
